ACTION FROM CONTRACT PROVISION REVISION

The Commission was presented with the following contract provision revision:

4.4.5 Staff Qualifications. Administrative staff, iInstructional staff, employees, and volunteers shall possess all applicable qualifications as required by state or federal law. Certificated administrators and iInstructional staff shall maintain active certification in accordance with chapter 28A.410 RCW, unless the instructional staff meets the requirements of RCW 28A.150.203(7). including adherence to the Instructional staff must also adhere to the code of professional conduct, ethical standards governing educator conduct, and associated laws and regulations. Certificated and licensed staff shall also be held accountable in accordance with the provisions of Title 28A RCW as well as any applicable state or federal laws

Commission Dziko moved to accept the provision revision and Commissioner Cato seconded, with the Commission voting to approve.
