Charter Public School Accountability Actions

Charter public schools in Washington are subject to an [accountability framework](#) overseen by the Washington State Charter School Commission, Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, State Auditor’s Office and each charter public school’s board

WASHINGTON – As part of its role in overseeing charter public schools in Washington, the State Auditor’s Office has released its regular accountability audit reports for the 2021-22 school year. Twelve out of 13 charter public schools authorized by the Commission had no findings. One school had two findings, which align with oversight action the [Washington State Charter School Commission previously identified](#) . One school (Rainier Prep) was not audited this year due to showing consistent results in previous audits.
