Chapter 108-10 WAC: Introduction: The purpose of the proposed rule is to align language in the Charter School Commission's rule with the language in the new charter school law (E2SSB 6194).

Chapter 108-20 WAC: Application: The purpose of the proposed rule is to align language in the Charter School Commission's rule with the language in the new charter school law (E2SSB 6194). There are no anticipated effects of the language changes, as the

changes being proposed are minor in nature and do not affect the intent or effect of the rule. In addition to the language changes being proposed, sections related to "conversion schools" are deleted in entirety, per the new law.

Chapter 108-40 WAC: Charter School Oversight and Corrective Action Policy, Renewal and Nonrenewal Policy, Revocation Policy, and Termination Protocol: The purpose of the proposed rule is to align language in the Charter School Commission's rule with the language in the new charter school law (E2SSB 6194).

Chapter: 108-50 WAC: Public Records: The purpose of the proposed rule is to update the Charter School Commission's public records officer and public records request processing protocol for Charter School Commission compliance with Public Records Act 42.56 RCW.
